2. No Objection Certificate:

3. **Age Limit:** Age limit refers to completed age in years as on last date of submission of application i.e. the date of walk-in-interview. Age Limit: Above 18 years and below 45 years.

5. **Short Listing:** After scrutiny/verification of the documents as per eligibility criteria/ conditions, only eligible candidates may appear before the selection committee for interview. Candidates who report for walk-in- interview must bring duly filled printed copy (single side) of the application form. No Objection Certificate from the current employer (for Govt. employees only) and produce all relevant original documents in proof of details furnished in their application at the time of interview.

6. Selection criteria after the scrutiny the candidate will be short listed based on marks, experience and personality test obtained (Marks-60%, Experience-20% and Personality test-20%) decided by the selection committee.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The candidate who is already in government service shall submit 'No Objection Certificate' from the present employer at the time of Interview.

3. The prescribed qualification is minimum and mere possessing the same does not entitle any candidate for selection.
4. The appointee shall not be granted any claim or right for regular appointment to any post of MIMS.
